

# 14.07. Barcode scanning and prescriptions

Added: Version 5.01

If you have turned on bacrode scanning for prescriptions (see the [15.09. Barcode scanning preferences](#) page for details) then, when you print out a prescription label, a second label containing a barcode will be printed with it. The label will look something like this:



When you scan this label from the prescription search window (choose *Patient > Show patients* in the menus) with a barcode scanner, it will open the prescription at the *Payment* tab ready for payment to be entered.
